

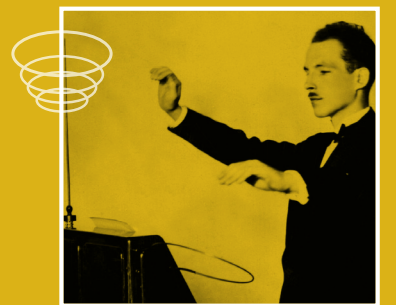

Invented c. 1917 by Russian engineer Lev Termen, the Theremin was one of the first electronic instruments. It uses a set of oscillators and antennae, which are played "in the air" with hand gestures.

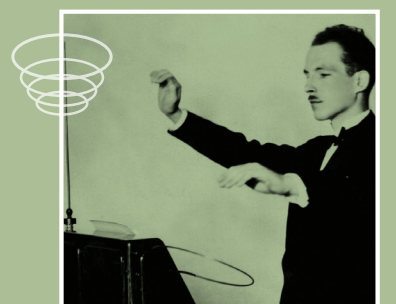
